KNOW YOUR ROLE

The chapter 15 from St. Luke's gospel is often considered the heart of the Gospel message. In three parables, Jesus sums up what his new Way of life is about. He demonstrates how we should relate to each other and to God. Jesus places the people in the world in four roles. Everybody has a role, but not all the roles are good. Jesus wants us all to be on the same team and to take those roles that help people in trouble.

In the first role are the lost. The sheep, the coin, and the younger son were lost. The lost are those who are caught up in a life of sin. St. Paul tells us that he was in this role in the past, when he persecuted Christians. To the lost Jesus says "return." No sin or past is so awful that Jesus will not forgive it and invite the sinner into membership in his Church.

In the second role are the seekers. The shepherd, the woman, and the father were seekers. They went after the lost ones, the sinners, to convert them and bring them back. The father does not go to the distant country seeking his younger son, but the thought of his father is what brings the son back. This reminds us that God is always seeking sinners and speaking to their conscience. God wants others to take this role of seeker too.

the third role the In are intercessors. Intercessors are those who go directly before God in prayer asking that he return the lost. Intercessors are often in the background. Moses took this role in the first reading when he asked God to spare the Israelites. The friends and neighbors of the shepherd and of the woman, and the servants of the father likely had this role. They rejoiced when the lost was found. Intercessors are necessary prayer warriors who support seekers in the background.

In the fourth and final role are the haters. This modern slang is the perfect description for these people. A hater is someone who can never be happy for another—who always must find a flaw or shortcoming to exploit. The older son in the parable and the

Scribes and Pharisees in real life were haters. They did not want the lost to be found unless these sinners came to them personally and begged for forgiveness. They could not stand the father's mercy toward sinners and expected better treatment for themselves, since they had never been lost.

Everybody in the world is in one of these four roles. We may switch roles at times, and we may have more than one role. Jesus wants us to be on the same team and to help those people who are in trouble.

Are you in the role of the lost? Jesus does not want you to keep this role. He does not want you to stay mired in a life of sin. He wants you back. Receive his mercy in Confession, and accept the help of his other followers so that you can avoid sin and grow in holiness.

Are you in the role of a hater? Jesus does not want you to keep this role. He does not want you to focus on the sins of others or to think you are better than they. He wants you to help sinners and to say along with St. Paul: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. Of these I am the foremost."

Are you in the role of a seeker? Jesus wants you to continue inviting sinners to conversion. This is the role that Jesus himself took. This is the reason that "Tax collectors and sinners were all drawing near to listen to" him. Encourage and invite people to get to know Jesus and to return to the sacraments. Remember also to ask for prayers from others to keep you strong.

Are you in the role of an intercessor? Jesus wants you to persevere in prayer. Conversion happens at the level of the heart—at the invisible level of the soul. This is where prayer works. Keep praying for sinners. Know that your prayers are affecting their hearts, like the heart of the younger son was moved to return to his father. Remember also to pray for seekers and to encourage them.

Take up the roles Jesus presents to us, seeking and interceding for sinners. Turn away from the roles of sinner and hater. Jesus offers us exciting roles in his plan of salvation. Let us play for his team.


