To appropriately observe First Fridays there will be Eucharistic adoration following the 9:30 am Mass until 11:00 am, when Benediction will be given.

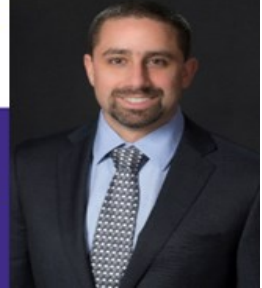
