THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

As we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi, we are reminded of the profound significance of the Eucharist in our lives. Today, we reflect on the readings of the day which emphasize the miraculous gift of Christ's Body and Blood, given to us for our salvation and sustenance.

As St. John Vianney said, "If we really understood the Mass, we would die of joy." Let us strive to be like the saints who cherished the Eucharist above all else.


