OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Dear Parishioners,

As we gather on this solemn feast of Christ the King, we are reminded of the profound truth that our Lord reigns as King of the Universe, a reign characterized not by power, but by love, mercy, and justice. The readings for today invite us to reflect on the nature of Christ's kingship and what it means for our lives in a world often clouded by uncertainty and division.

In the book of Daniel (7:13-14), we witness a vision of the Son of Man receiving dominion and glory from the Ancient of Days. This imagery reminds us that Christ's authority is not one that demands submission through fear, but one that invites us to enter into a relationship of love and service. In the Gospel of John (18:33b-37), we see Jesus standing before Pilate, affirming that His Kingdom is not of this world. This challenges us to reflect on

where we place our allegiances. Are we swayed by the fleeting powers of this world, or do we stand firm in our commitment to Christ, the true King? As we face the trials and tribulations of modern life, let us be emboldened by His example, choosing to be peacemakers in our communities and heralds of His Kingdom.

As we celebrate Christ the King today, let us renew our commitment to live in His light, embodying His love in a world that desperately needs it. May we be reminded that our true identity is found in Christ, who invites us to reign with Him through acts of love and service.

In the words of Pope Francis, "The Church is called to be the house of the Father, with doors wide open." Let us be that welcoming presence in our parish and beyond, as we proclaim the reign of Christ in our hearts and lives.

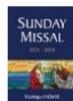


St. John Vianney Parish CWL Annual Membership Drive for 2025

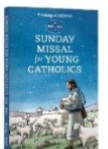

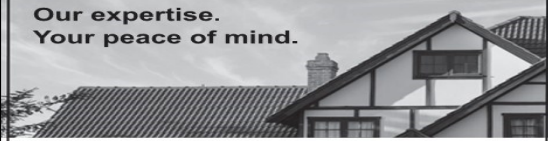
