## "HERE I AM, LORD — CALLED AND SENT"

This Sunday's readings invite us to reflect on **God's call** and our response. Whether it is Isaiah's vision, Paul's encounter with the risen Christ, or Simon Peter's awe before Jesus, each passage reveals how an ordinary person, despite their unworthiness, is transformed by divine grace and sent forth in mission. These readings challenge us: How do we respond to God's call in our daily lives?

### First Reading: Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8 – A Call to Holiness and Mission

The prophet Isaiah describes a magnificent vision of God's glory, with angels crying, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" Overwhelmed by the divine presence, Isaiah feels unworthy, crying out, "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips" (v. 5). But God purifies him and calls him into service. Isaiah responds with courage: "Here am I; send me!"

Isaiah's encounter reminds us that no one is too unworthy to be used by God. God does not call the perfect—He perfects those He calls. St. Augustine once said, "God does not choose the qualified; He qualifies the chosen." We, too, are called to holiness, to listen for God's voice, and to respond with openness.

### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:3-8, 11 – The Core of Our Faith

St. Paul reminds the Corinthians of the Gospel he received and passed on: "Christ died for our sins... he was buried... he was raised on the third day" (vv. 3-4). He recounts the appearances of the risen Christ, even to himself, the "least of the apostles" (v. 9).

Paul's story is one of transformation. Once a persecutor of Christians, he became a tireless missionary. His experience tells us that **God's grace is greater than our past mistakes**. No matter what we have done, God's mercy can renew us and call us into His service. As St. John Vianney said, "Our sins are but a grain of sand compared to the great mountain of God's mercy."

### Gospel: Luke 5:1-11 - "Do Not Be Afraid"

The Gospel presents the miraculous catch of fish. After a fruitless night, Simon Peter and his companions, at Jesus' command, cast their nets again—and catch so many fish that their boats begin to sink! Overwhelmed, Peter falls to his knees: "Go away from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man!" But Jesus tells him, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people" (v. 10).

Peter's reaction echoes Isaiah's: the awareness of one's sinfulness before divine holiness. Yet, Jesus does not reject Peter—He **calls him to a higher purpose**. Peter and his companions leave everything and follow Him.

This Gospel challenges us: How often do we let fear, doubt, or feelings of unworthiness hold us back from responding to Jesus? Maybe we feel we are not "holy enough" or "knowledgeable enough" to serve God. But Jesus reassures us: He does not call us because we are perfect, but because He loves us and will equip us.

### Bringing the Message Home - Our Own "Yes" to God

These readings speak to us today:

- 1. God calls us despite our imperfections like Isaiah, Paul, and Peter, we may feel unworthy, but God sees our potential.
- 2. **Grace transforms us** no past mistake is too great for God's mercy.
- 3. **Jesus invites us to trust Him** we must cast our "nets" in faith, even when the waters seem empty.

This week, let us ask: Where is God calling me? How can I respond with a willing heart? Let us say with Isaiah: "Here am I; send me."

May God bless you and guide you in your journey of faith.




