### The Jubilee Year and the Season of Lent: A Journey of Hope and Renewal

"The season of Lent during this Jubilee Year should be lived more intensely as a

privileged moment to celebrate and experience God's mercy." Pope Francis, Bull of Indiction #17

When Pope Francis opened the Holy Doors in St. Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve, he inaugurated the Jubilee Year 2025. The Jubilee Year is a sacred time in the Catholic Church that occurs every 25 years. It is a period of renewal, a chance to grow closer to God, and an opportunity to seek His mercy and forgiveness. The theme for the upcoming Jubilee Year, Pilgrims of Hope, emphasizes the journey that all people of faith are called to focusing on trust in God and undertake, perseverance in His promise. Pilgrims of Hope, encourages us to place our trust in God's infinite love and compassion. Pope Francis teaches that true hope comes from God's kindness, which offers healing and renewal to all.

The Jubilee Year calls us to deepen our faith through the Lenten practices of *prayer*, *fasting*, *acts of charity*, and seeking God's grace. These spiritual practices help us experience God's love more fully and open our hearts to transformation and reconciliation.

## Lent: A Pilgrimage of Hope through Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving

Lent is a journey, much like being a pilgrim during the Jubilee Year. To be *Pilgrims of Hope* during Lent, we must trust in God's mercy, which is always greater than our shortcomings. Prayer is a vital part of this journey, helping us strengthen our faith and recognize the areas in our lives that need healing. Spending time in personal prayer, attending Mass, and receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation bring us closer to God. These acts remind us that God welcomes us with open arms, offering us forgiveness and a fresh start

Fasting means giving up certain comforts to focus on God, a way to remove the obstacles that get in our way, that is something that we are perhaps too attached to. It helps people rely more on their faith and less on material things. During this Jubilee Year, fasting is a way to renew one's heart and grow stronger in self-discipline and trust in God. When

combined with prayer and the Jubilee Indulgence, fasting becomes a meaningful way to experience God's mercy.

Helping others is another important part of Lent and the Jubilee Year. In the Bible, the Jubilee was a time of forgiveness, when debts were erased and captives were set free. As *Pilgrims of Hope*, we share Christ's light by serving others and showing kindness. Giving to the poor, volunteering, and supporting charitable causes are ways we can live out our faith. These acts of charity (almsgiving), remind us that our mission as Christians is to bring hope to others and to reflect God's love in our actions. The Holy Father also asks us to reflect on our role in addressing unjust social structures that exclude or oppress our brothers and sisters.

The Jubilee Year and Lent both call us to be *Pilgrims* of *Hope*—people who trust in God's promises and extend His mercy to others. By fully embracing the Lenten journey, we walk the path of hope, preparing to receive the full blessings of this sacred year.


