## EASTER MESSAGE APRIL 20, 2025

### HIS EMINENCE FRANK CARDINAL LEO METROPOLITAN ARCHBISHOP OF TORONTO

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

May Jesus and Mary be in your souls.

The greatest liturgical celebration of the Church is Easter. The traditional Easter greeting—Christus surréxit! – Surréxit vere, allelúja! ("Christ is risen! – He is risen indeed, Alleluia!")—fills us with renewed hope and trust in the Lord Jesus, our Saviour. How can we not rejoice in the singular event of Jesus rising from the tomb outside Jerusalem? He is alive—among us, in our hearts, in the sacraments, in his Word, and in his Church. By his death, we are freed from all sin; by his Resurrection, we are given new life, new beginnings, and new hope.

With that incomparable Easter joy, I extend warm greetings to you and your loved ones this Easter and throughout the season.

Easter is the central solemnity of our faith—the day we celebrate Christ's victory over sin, death, and Satan (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 102). Each Sunday Mass is a weekly encounter with the Risen Lord, a moment of grace not to be missed. Let us recommit to our Sunday worship, celebrating the Eucharistic Jesus who draws us deeper into his newness and abundant life.

This Easter also takes place during the Jubilee Holy Year, when we are called to be Pilgrims of Hope. As Pope Francis reminds us: "The death and resurrection of Jesus is the heart of our faith and the basis of our hope" (Spes non Confundit, 20). This hope is not vague optimism but grounded in the love of the Most Holy Trinity. The Easter Preface proclaims: "By dying he has destroyed our death, and by rising restored our

life." These truths shape us and make the life of grace available to us (cf. CCC, 654).

The Resurrection, though historical, is far more than a past event. It transcends time and space. As the Catechism teaches, Christ's Resurrection was not a return to earthly life but an entry into a new, glorified existence (CCC, 646). It is the fulfillment of our deepest longing for God and eternal life (cf. St. Augustine, Confessions, I, i,5).

For those who grieve, Easter hope offers consolation: death does not have the final word. At funerals we pray: "In him the hope of blessed resurrection has dawned..." This is the comfort and strength of those who mourn.

Easter hope is transformative. It calls us to live differently—more lovingly, truthfully, and courageously. Like Mary Magdalene, we are sent to proclaim the Good News: the tomb is empty, Jesus is risen! In our words and deeds, let us share with all the joy of knowing Christ and the difference he makes in our lives.

Once again, I extend heartfelt Easter wishes to you, your families, and our entire Archdiocese. May the joy of Easter bring daily renewal, trust, and hope, as we journey together toward the life that never ends.

Blessed Easter to you all.


