FAITH, GRATITUDE, AND HEALING: A HEART THAT GIVES THANKS

Dear Parish Family,

On this Thanksgiving Weekend, I extend to each of you, parishioners, families, and cherished visitors, warmest greetings of peace and joy. Happy Thanksgiving! As your pastor, I thank God for you with all my heart. Your faith, generosity, prayers, and presence are the life of our parish. The countless ways you contribute, seen and unseen, allow St. John Vianney Parish to be a home of worship, service, and fellowship. Today, I thank God for your love and support, and I thank you for the privilege of walking with you in faith. Truly, "give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1 Thess 5:18).

Scripture's Call to Gratitude

The readings this Sunday invite us into the mystery of gratitude as an act of faith. In the Gospel (Luke 17:11–19), Jesus heals ten lepers, yet only one, a Samaritan returns to give thanks. His gratitude becomes an encounter of salvation: "Your faith has made you well." Gratitude is not simply a polite gesture; it is a recognition of God's mercy that transforms our lives.

In the first reading (2 Kings 5:14–17), Naaman the Syrian is cleansed of leprosy and responds with profound thanksgiving. He promises to worship the Lord alone, acknowledging that healing has led him to true faith. St. Paul, in the second reading (2 Tim 2:8–13), reminds us that even in suffering and trials, we can remain faithful because "if we endure, we will also reign with Him." Thanksgiving is thus not seasonal; it is a lifelong disposition of a Christian heart.

Theological Wisdom on Gratitude

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that thanksgiving is at the heart of Christian prayer: "Every joy and suffering, every event and need can become the matter for thanksgiving which, sharing in that of Christ, should fill one's whole life" (CCC 2638).

St. Augustine wrote: "The Christian should be an alleluia from head to foot." Gratitude turns our entire existence into praise. St. Thomas Aquinas noted that thanksgiving is an act of justice, we render to God what is due to Him for His gifts. Gratitude, then, is more than a feeling; it is a moral and spiritual responsibility.

Gratitude in Our Time

Dear friends, our world often moves so quickly that we forget to pause and give thanks. We focus on what we

lack, rather than what we have received. Yet when we stop and name our blessings, faith, family, health, community, even the trials that strengthen us; we discover joy and peace.

Think of the leper who returned: he had the same healing as the others, but his thanksgiving opened him to a deeper relationship with Christ. Gratitude does the same for us. Whether in times of abundance or challenge, it changes how we see ourselves, others, and God. It heals hearts burdened by complaints, fears, and regrets.

Thanksgiving and Parish Life

This weekend especially, I thank God for our parish. I thank the staff, the volunteers who serve with generosity; the families who hand on the faith to their children; the elderly who witness perseverance in prayer; the youth who bring fresh energy and hope; and every person who comes to this church seeking the face of Christ. You are a blessing.

Let us continue to live as a grateful people. Let our thanksgiving not be limited to one weekend, but let it shape our daily living. May we echo the words of the Psalmist: "O give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever" (Ps 107:1).

A Word of Blessing

On this Thanksgiving Weekend, may our homes be filled with gratitude, our tables with joy, and our hearts with peace. May we be like the one who returned to Christ, giving thanks for healing, mercy, and salvation.

From my heart to yours: Happy Thanksgiving! Thank you for your faith, your prayers, and your love for St. John Vianney Parish. May God bless you and your families abundantly.
