## **Important Dates**

June – September 2025 - We invite you to start the registration process by completing an online application through the parish website. PLEASE NOTE: REGISTRATION IS NOT COMPLETE until you attend the in-person class and date selection event listed below.

(You must bring a copy of your child's baptismal certificate to the event even if your child was baptized at St. John Vianney.)

**September 19, 2025** - 7:00 pm **sharp** - Parent and student must register and attend the first class at St. John Vianney Church in order to request a Confirmation date.

OR

**September 20, 2025** - 1:00 pm **sharp** - Parent and student must register and attend the first class at St. John Vianney Church in order to request a Confirmation date.

**October 25/26, 2025** – Family and student attend any parish Sunday Mass to receive an enrollment cross.

**November 19, 2025** – Family and student to attend Wednesday evening at 7:00 pm to hear an Instructional Mass and to read their parent letter.

**December 2025, January 2026 –** Family viewing of online videos (home)

**February 14/15, 2026** – Family and student attend any parish Sunday Mass to donate food to the St. Vincent de Paul and to receive prayers.

**March 6/7, 2026** – Parent and student attend activity and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
