Important Dates

September 2024 - Look for registration information from your child's local Catholic school the third week of the month. At that time information will also be available in the vestibule of our Church or on the parish website.

(Registration will require a copy of your child's baptismal certificate even if your child was baptized at St. John Vianney.)

October 4, 2024 - 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm - Parent and student register and attend the first class at St. John Vianney Church

OR

October 5, 2024 - 1:00 pm – 2:30 pm - Parent and student register and attend the first class at St. John Vianney Church

November 9/10, 2024 – Family and student attend any parish Sunday Mass to hear an “Instructional” Mass and to receive an enrollment cross.

December 7/8, 2024 – Family and student attend any parish Sunday Mass to receive a textbook and to read a parent letter.

January 18/19, 2025 – Family and student attend any parish Sunday Mass to donate food to the St. Vincent de Paul and to receive prayers.
